PAID YIDDISH FELLOWSHIP:

THE IRENE KRONHILL PLETKA YIVO RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

WHO: Everyone! Open to CC, Barnard, GS, SEAS, SOA, SIPA, TC, JTS, and GSAS students who have taken at least **TWO SEMESTERS** of Yiddish language at Columbia University prior to commencing the Fellowship.

WHAT: Paid Yiddish research fellowship: A semester-long fellowship entails the minimum of **45 research hours** spent at the YIVO Institute for Jewish Research (approximately 3 hours a week). 2 hours a week for YIVO determined tasks, 1 hour a week for own research. A short presentation required upon completion. **\$1,500 stipend.**

WHERE: MANHATTAN, NEW YORK

WHEN: ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027

Deadline for applications for the fall semester is September 30, and for the spring semester, space permitting, January 31st. Applications must be emailed to Dr. Agi Legutko at a.legutko@columbia.edu.

WHY: Enhance your exploration of Yiddish language, literature, culture, while refining your research skills, and get paid doing what you love: Yiddish research!
